ONEKIDZ PROGRAMME



INTRODUCTION

OneKidz is a developmental racial harmony programme for children, which aims to inculcate racial harmony values from a young age. It is important that we start young to imbibe values of multi-racialism. Starting early will give our students the right foundation and attitude towards racial integration.

OneKidz is an innovative outreach programme meant to educate upper primary school students of the intricacies of racial harmony. The programme will create a platform for children to be aware of the key customs, culture and practices of our major ethnic groups, appreciate our cultural diversity and encourage bonding.



AIMS

OneKidz therefore aims to:

- ◆ Raise awareness among children on the background, traditions, of the major ethnic communities as well as the festivals and rites of major religious groups in a fun and interactive manner;
- ◆ Educate the young on the need to embrace diversity and imbibe values of Racial Harmony; and
- ◆ Enable children of different races (and nationalities) to interact and bond with each other through fun and engaging enrichment activities

PROGRAMME

Session 1: Culture, Customs & Costumes

- ◆ Understand some of the history, language and famous people of the various races
- ◆ Learn ways in which people within an ethnic group greet one another
- ◆ Identify elements of filial piety within each ethnic group
- ◆ Wear or draw costumes of each ethnic group
- ◆ Identify some of the do's and don'ts for each of the races

Session 2: Food, Special Occasions & Celebrations

- ◆ Identify the types of special occasions and celebrations of the various races
- ◆ List of things that people do during the special occasions and celebrations
- ◆ Identify types of delicacies of each ethnic group
- ◆ Draw specified types of cakes
- ◆ Make a Singaporean Cake

Session 3: Marriage, Births, Death & Beliefs

- ◆ Identify major beliefs of each ethnic group
- ◆ Identify ways in which the different ethnic groups put together a wedding
- ◆ Identify ways in which the different ethnic groups welcome a baby into the family
- ◆ Identify ways in which the different ethnic groups send off their loved ones to the next world



Session 4: Embracing Diversity

- ◆ Identify ways that we, as Singaporeans, can embrace the idea of multicultural living
- ◆ Identify common values and aspirations for a growing nation
- ◆ List values that can assist in building trust and good relationships

Each session is 1.5 hours and this allows ample time for learning and interaction on each topic. Each session will provide hands-on activities for the children to understand the key learning values. This way, the students "learn by doing". At the end of each session, discussions will be held to ensure students understand the various aspects and underlying key messages.
