Over 200 multi-racial youths will work hand in hand in piecing together the Singapore's Largest Paper Ball Mosaic Display at the Finale of CampTeen: Youth Racial Harmony Ambassadors Programme 2008 – OnePeople.sg's flagship youth programme on Tuesday, 4 November 2008 from 11:30am – 1.30pm at OnePeople.sg.

Mayor Zainudin Nordin, Mayor, Central Singapore District and Chairman, OnePeople.sg will grace the event as Guest of Honour. This event will be the Finale of a 4D3N residential camp programme which hones cross cultural understanding and initiates leadership and action among our youth in promoting racial harmony and social cohesion. The programme is also supported by National Youth Council.

Youths from SAP schools, Neighbourhood Secondary Schools, Self-Help Groups, Youth Organisations will be participating in **CampTeen: Youth Racial Harmony Ambassadors Programme 2008**. They will create a multi-coloured work of art as a showcase of multiculturalism in Singapore and demonstrate the value of social cohesiveness among Singaporeans. The Paper Ball Mosaic Display will be made up of tiny multi-coloured paper balls forming the word 'ONE PEOPLE' on a 15" by 7" wide board. Working together in synchronization, these youths of different cultures, races and religions will align their goals towards the same path of creating a symbol and representation of one people in Singapore. Mayor Zainudin Nordin will put the finishing touches of the Singapore's Largest Paper Ball Mosaic.

The youth's attempt in setting the record of the Largest Paper Ball Mosaic will be followed by a presentation of their youth advocacy project ideas developed during the camp. The presentation of CampTeen 2008 participants' community and advocacy project ideas on the theme of Multi-culturalism will showcase their leadership and project management skills as well as the cross cultural learning they had experienced during the Camp.

Camp Teen enables participants to have an exciting opportunity to experience working and learning with students from various secondary schools and youth organisations in a multi-cultural and multi-racial setting. They will also be participating in an amazing race across Singapore's unique ethnic enclaves, multi-ethnic treats, cultural dance, team-strategic games, outdoor adventure and campfire. The photo montage presentation will review the experiences that the youths have shared in the 4D3N camp, as well as be a reflection on what they have learnt about themselves, their friends and the different cultures in Singapore.

Certificates will be presented to the participants of CampTeen: Youth Racial Harmony Ambassadors Programme 2008, marking the debut of over 200 multi-racial youths as OnePeople.sg's Youth Racial Harmony Ambassadors.
